UnitedHealthcare Community Plan in Texas is sharing this information from the Texas Health and Human Services Commission so you know what the state requires when billing for **Adult Preventive Checkups**.



UnitedHealthcare Community Plan in Texas offers an annual well check for adults ages 21 and older. Please review this information to better understand Texas Medicaid billing procedures when submitting claims for adult preventive checkups for STAR and STAR+PLUS members.

## Submitting Adult Preventive Checkup Claims

Annual adult well checkups are a benefit of Texas Medicaid for members ages 21 and older. The checkup is limited to one service per rolling year with any provider.

Annual checkup claims must be submitted with one of the following diagnosis codes:

- Z0000
- Z0001
- Z01411
- Z01419

CPT® codes for annual checkups include:

- 99385-99387
- 99395-99397
