

Pharmacy Prior Authorization for Rinvoq™ Delayed: Now Starting March 15, 2020

The prior authorization requirement for Rinvoq™ is being delayed and will now start **March 15, 2020**. Rinvoq is used to treat rheumatoid arthritis. The details of the drug that will require prior authorization are listed in the following chart:
